Employment: 29 Jul 1799 in England; private in 13th light dragoons. 29 Jul 1799 to 16 Aug 1808. Located in Trowbridge then York between 1799 - 1800, East Anglia in Mar 1801, then Hounslow, Richmond and, Twickenham in 1802. By 1803 moved to Kent and possibly Taunton
Employment: 17 Aug 1808 in England; Private in 11th Royal Veterans Battalion until 24 Jun 1815. Based in Bexhill and Winchelsea 1808 - 1810, Winchelsea, Isle of Man, Anholt and Hythe. 1815 based in Isle of Man
Employment: 25 Jun 1815 in London, England; private in 5th Royal Veteran's Battalion based at Tower of London until he was discharged 13th March 1816
